PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT, RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

In consideration of the services of the Atlanta Dragon Boat Festival Inc, their agents, owners, officers, volunteers, participants, employees, and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on their behalf (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Festival"), I hereby agree to release indemnify, and discharge the Festival, on behalf of myself, my spouse, my children, my parents, my heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate as follows:

 I acknowledge that my participation in Dragon Boat racing entails known and unanticipated risks that could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death, or damage to myself, to property, or to third parties. I understand that such risks simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity.

This risk includes, among other things: boat capsize; tidal conditions and currents; collision with objects or other watercraft; prolonged exposure to cold water, hypothermia, accidental drowning; illness in remote areas; exposure to sun, strong wind, cold storms, waves and lightening; aggressive and/or poisonous marine life; wrist, arm shoulder, and/or back injuries; slips and falls; and rapidly changing adverse weather and water conditions.

Furthermore, the Festival organizers have difficult jobs to perform. They seek safety, but they are not infallible. They might be unaware of a participant's fitness or abilities.
